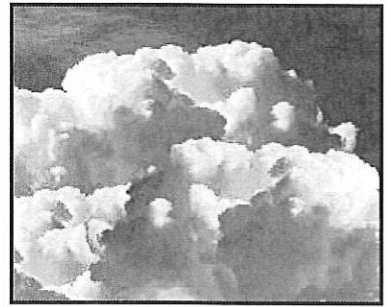


# The Cloud Song

(Sung to the tune of "Do You Know the Muffin Man")

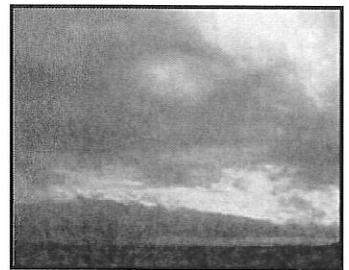
Cumulus clouds are piled up high,

sheets of gray, sheets of gray.

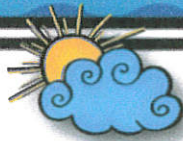
Stratus clouds are sheets of gray,
